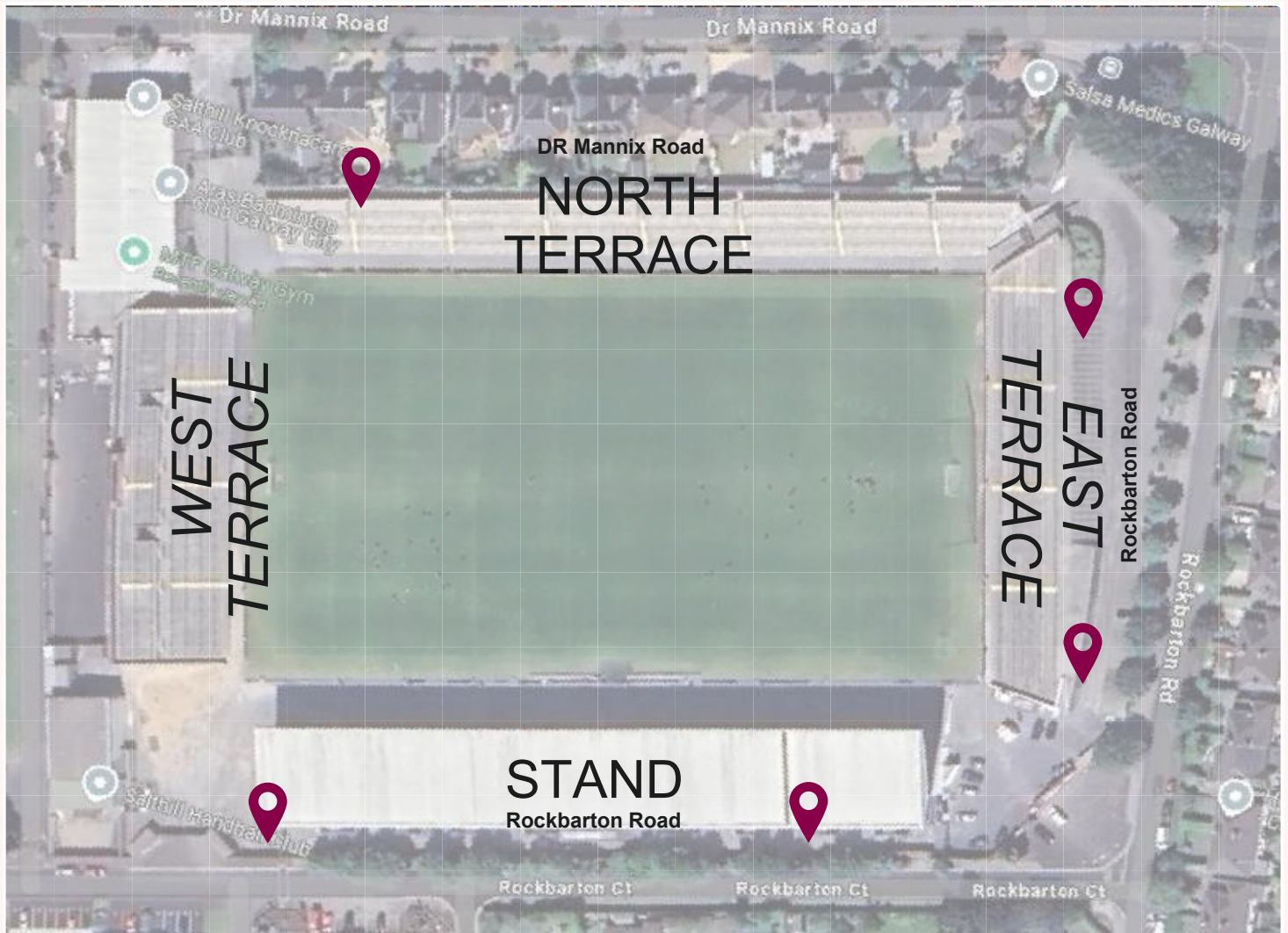
YOUR TICKETS

Please have your ticket open on your phone (or printed) before reaching the turnstile and ensure your phone is sufficiently charged

- This is a sold out game- no tickets will be available to purchase at the grounds on the day.
- Turnstiles will be open for the Terraces at the Main Entrance on Rockbarton Road and Arus Bóthar na Trá on Dr. Mannix Road.
- Entry to the Stand is via the gates at the back of the Stand.
- **Access to the Stand is on a first-come, first-served basis and is subject to capacity. Gates will open from 12 noon.**
- All tickets are general admission.

Please follow the instructions of Gardaí and stewards, if you need any assistance just ask.

ENTRY POINTS



You can enter via the East Terrace (Rockbarton Road) or North Terrace (Dr Mannix Road).

Turnstiles will also be open via behind the stand (Rockbarton Road).

PARKING

- Supporters are requested to allow for an extra one and a half hours travel time when planning their journey.
- Parking is limited in the vicinity of Pearse Stadium, we encourage supporters to use the multi-story car parks available around the city centre and on the Dyke Road: walk time approx 30-40 minutes or take public transport to/from Salthill.
- There will be a regular bus services from the city centre to Salthill throughout the day: **401, 402, 410, 411.**



ROAD CLOSURES

Road closures will be in effect in the following: **from 11am**

- On Salthill Prom at the junctions with Dalysfort Road and at Rockbarton West (by the Circle of Life Garden/Quincentennial Park).
- At Rockbarton Road (after the vehicular entrance to Leisureland)
- On Salthill Road Upper at the junction with Lenaboy Gardens.
- Lower Salthill at the Devon Park junction.
- Taylor's Hill at the Rosary Lane junction.
- The junction of Threadneedle Road and Dr Mannix Road.
